Literacy

Talk for writing: The three little pigs

- Sequencing pictures from the story
- Learn and join in re-telling the story, using the repeated refrains and actions.
- Innovate part of the story, thinking about different types of characters.
- Listen to different versions of the 3 Little pigs story and compare.
- Learn about speech bubbles and how they are used.
- Learn about how adjectives are used to describe.
- Use our phonics to write descriptions of the characters, speech bubbles, a 'wanted' poster for the wolf and to label elements of the story.

Physical Development

- Joining materials to build (with junk and construction kits).
- PE lessons developing jumping, speed and agility, balance and co-ordination, fitness and strength.
- Fine motor skills activities and pencil control.

- Discuss where is your favourite place to be and why.
- , Discuss why we love our homes.

- Understanding that some places are special to members of the community.

Understanding the World

- Understand where we live using a map (whole world and country).
- Look at different types of homes that we live in.
- Look at different types of homes around the world and discuss why they need to be different.
- Learn about the different materials used for buildings and their properties.
- Learn about different religious buildings.
- Talk about and name members of their own family, specifically those they live with.
